Year Founded: 1978

Mission: Our mission is to assist the community by providing a means to place unwanted healthy, adoptable pets in good family environments and to make the public aware of animal issues such as care, welfare, and the hazards of overpopulation. We pledge to elevate the status of animals in society by changing the way people acquire them and how they commit to those pets who become a part of their family; to relieve the plight of homeless pets; to reduce the overpopulation of cats and dogs; and to provide medical care and/or socialization to all animals in our care.

Summary of work: Adopt-A-Pet finds loving families for homeless dogs and cats and assists people in the community with their personal animals.

Project name and purpose: The Medical Center Upgrade will allow us to at least double the number of animals treated with at least 500 more animals receiving subsidized medical care in the first year.

Details of Proposed Project: Adopt-A-Pet is seeking to expand its Medical Center from 600 sq. ft. to 1600 sq. ft. which will help people and animals in need in Genesee County with affordable, accessible spays, neuters, and medical care.

Goals and Objectives: The increased space will allow for two doctors to perform surgery instead of one, add recovery space for more animals, and provide a larger check-in space. There will be dedicated lab space and a lead-lined x-ray room.

Implementation Timeline: 7-12 months

Target population: Pet owners in financial need, rescue groups/shelters, and homeless

animals

Number served: An additional 500 animals in the first year
