Year Founded: 1992

**Mission:** The mission of The Disability Network (TDN) is to revolutionize communities to be inclusive and accepting, where all people thrive in the quality of life they create.

**Summary of work:** TDN supports Genesee County through five core support areas. Our primary programs include Information and Referral, Advocacy, Transition Services, Peer Support, and Independent Living Skills. TDN works to increase independence and quality of life for people with disabilities in Genesee County.

**Project name and purpose:** Breaking Barriers: A Leadership Program for Youth with Disabilities is designed to cultivate the potential of high school-aged youth with disabilities to empower them to become effective leaders in their communities and beyond.

**Details of Proposed Project:** Breaking Barriers is a transformative experience that empowers young individuals with disabilities to embrace their strengths, reduce barriers, and become catalysts for positive change in their communities.

**Goals and Objectives:** Provide 40 Genesee County high school-aged youth comprehensive workshops covering a range of topics, including communication skills, digital literacy, self-advocacy, goal setting, problem-solving, teamwork, and adaptive leadership techniques tailored to their independent living success.

**Implementation Timeline:** 13-18 months

Target population: High school-aged youth with disabilities

**Number served:** TDN does not currently have a youth program. Breaking Barriers would allow them to serve 40 high school-aged youth with disabilities. The funding would also build a base curriculum that can be used in future years and shared with other Disability Networks across Michigan.
